• Housing Enforcement: Faulkner v. Metro Real Estate HU-0047-A18

The Complainant was paid \$40,892 by Metro Real Estate and the Commission received \$10,000 from Metro Real Estate for a civil penalty.

Director Quintana is working with the Controller's office to have the civil penalty deposited into Metro's account. Once the funds are deposited, Director Quintana will present a plan to spend them for approval from the commission.
